Settlement in Adult Day Health Care Case OK'd

On Tuesday, a federal judge granted final approval [a recent settlement](#) in a lawsuit challenging the state's plan to eliminate the adult day health care program. Under the settlement, about half of the 35,000 participants in the ADHC program beginning in March will be eligible to join the new Community-Based Adult Services program, while the rest of the participants will receive case management services that allow them to continue living at home.
