

Rally against adult day care cuts set for Tuesday

POWAY — A rally will be held Tuesday at the Poway Adult Day Health Care Center to protest cuts to state adult day care scheduled to take effect Dec. 1 under a budget-reduction plan by Gov. Jerry Brown.

The rally will be from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. in the center's parking lot, 12250 Crosthwaite Circle in the Poway Business Park.

Adult day health care programs serve about 27,000 Californians.

Poway Adult Day Health Care is a nonprofit that has been in operation since 2002. It provides therapy programs for those who might suffer memory loss and physical decline from diseases, such as Alzheimer's.
