



# 2010 ADULT DAY HEALTH CARE (ADHC) MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES AND DUES

For facilities licensed by California Department of Public Health

Revised 2009-10-29

## CAADS Membership Year is January 1 through December 31

Membership in CAADS is for a facility/business. Licensees operating more than one facility are required to place ALL facilities into membership as a GROUP\* and a membership application for each adult day services facility must be submitted in order for application/s to be processed. *GROUPS are eligible for a dues discount based on the combined revenue of all facilities.*

## New Members Pay Dues According to When They Join

<u>APPLICATION &amp; DUES TO CAADS</u>	<u>PRORATED – YOU PAY</u>
January 1 to February 28	100% of Annual Dues Rate
March 1 to April 30	80% of Annual Dues Rate
May 1 to June 30	60% of Annual Dues Rate
July 1 to September 30	50% of Annual Dues Rate
October 1 to December 31	100% of Annual Dues Rate <i>(to get 13, 14 or 15 months for the price of 12!)</i>

## Membership Classifications *(Categories, Dues and Benefits information is available for each)*

- ∞ **Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) Membership:** Pre-licensed | Newly Licensed/New Ownership | Licensed
- ∞ **Adult Day Program (ADP) Membership:** Pre-licensed | Newly Licensed/New Ownership | Licensed
- ∞ **Associate (ASOC) Membership:** Consultant | Vendor | Allied/Government Organization | Corporate Office  
*Associate membership is not permitted for those with an ownership or employment (administrator/program director) relationship with one or more adult day services facilities unless ALL such adult day services facilities are in membership with CAADS.*

### PRE-LICENSED ADHC | *Non-Voting* | Annual Dues \$250

Non-licensed facility in *process of ADHC licensure* with the California Department of Public Health, which is not scheduled to be licensed within 90 days, or individuals/businesses exploring the viability of opening an adult day services facility. Membership at this category is granted for a maximum of three (3) membership years or until licensure, whichever is sooner.

*If within 90 days of licensure, join at Newly Licensed/New Ownership level. Those who already own/operate a licensed adult day services facility are ineligible for Pre-Licensed membership unless all their licensed facilities are in membership with CAADS.*

### NEWLY LICENSED/NEW OWNERSHIP ADHC | *Voting* | Annual Dues Based on Year 1, 2, 3 of Licensure/Ownership

Adult day health care facility licensed less than three (3) years with the California Department of Public Health. Membership at this category is granted for a maximum of three (3) membership years.

- Year 1 Newly Licensed/New Ownership: \$ 600 Annual Dues Rate
- Year 2 Newly Licensed/New Ownership: \$ 1,000 Annual Dues Rate or 50% of Licensed rate based on actual gross revenue, *whichever is less*
- Year 3 Newly Licensed/New Ownership: \$ 1,500 Annual Dues Rate or 50% of Licensed rate based on actual gross revenue, *whichever is less*

### LICENSED ADHC | *Voting* | Annual Dues Based on Actual Gross Revenue for Most Recent Fiscal Year End

Adult day health care facility currently licensed by California Department of Public Health. Membership applicant is the facility/licensee.

*A licensee operating more than one facility is required to place ALL facilities into membership as a GROUP\*. ADHCs operating an ADP within the ADHC license must pay dues according to CAADS ADHC Membership Dues Rate Schedule.*

#### \*DISCOUNT Dues Rate for GROUP Selecting COMBINED Revenue Method

One voting representative designated on behalf of the group of adult day services facilities.

Each additional facility in group entitled to one designated representative for CAADS communications and otherwise entitled to full member privileges. Dues rate is based on the most recent fiscal year end total combined actual gross revenue of ALL facilities in Group.

#### \*REGULAR Dues Rate for GROUP Selecting SEPARATE Revenue Method

One voting representative designated for each and every adult day services facility in the group.

Each facility in group entitled to one designated representative for CAADS communications and entitled to full member privileges. Dues rate is based on separate gross revenue for each and every adult day services facility (ADHC and/or ADP) in Group

(1) Complete the Application for Membership, (2) Include copy of documents, if indicated, (3) Include dues payment according to Membership Categories & Dues document, and (4) Send to the CAADS office.

***Membership application cannot be processed until application, all required attachments, and dues are received.***

*Provisional Membership* is granted until application is reviewed by the Membership Committee at its monthly meeting.

- If application is approved, a confirmation letter with membership certificate and ID number will be mailed.
- If application is denied, notification will be mailed and a pro-rated refund issued.
