### CAADS Membership Year is January 1 through December 31

Associate members are non adult day services providers offering goods, services or support to the adult day services industry. ### New Members Pay Dues According to When They Join

<u>APPLICATION &amp; DUES TO CAADS</u>	<u>PRORATED – YOU PAY</u>
January 1 to February 28	100% of Annual Dues Rate
March 1 to April 30	80% of Annual Dues Rate
May 1 to June 30	60% of Annual Dues Rate
July 1 to September 30	50% of Annual Dues Rate
October 1 to December 31	100% of Annual Dues Rate <i>(to get 13, 14 or 15 months for the price of 12!)</i>

### Membership Classifications *(Categories, Dues and Benefits information is available for each)*

- ☞ **Associate (ASOC) Membership:** Allied/Government Organization | Consultant | Corporate Office | Vendor  
*Associate membership is **not permitted** for those with an ownership or employment (administrator/program director) relationship with one or more adult day services facilities unless ALL such adult day services facilities are in membership with CAADS.*
- ☞ **Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) Membership:** Pre-licensed | Newly Licensed/New Ownership | Licensed
- ☞ **Adult Day Program (ADP) Membership:** Pre-licensed | Newly Licensed/New Ownership | Licensed

### ALLIED/GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION | *Non-Voting* | Annual Dues \$225

Health or social services organization, community based long-term care organization, association or network:

- Nursing Home ▪ Hospital ▪ Residential Care Facility for the Elderly ▪ Adult Residential Facility ▪ Physician Practice
- Managed Care ▪ Intermediate Care Facility ▪ Home Health Agency ▪ Area Agency on Aging ▪ Government Department/Agency
- MSSP ▪ Linkages ▪ Caregiver Resource Center ▪ Regional Center ▪ Network ▪ Association ▪ Educational Institution

*Those operating, providing or seeking licensure for an adult day services program are ineligible for Allied/Government Organization membership. See ADHC and/or ADP membership categories, dues and benefits.*

### CONSULTANT | *Non-Voting* | Annual Dues \$550

Business or individual offering start-up or operational consulting to adult day services providers.

Consultants holding any of the following relationships with one or more adult day services facilities must bring EACH such facility into membership before becoming eligible for Associate-Consultant membership:

- Stockholder or operating entity ▪ Administrator of Record ▪ Program Director of Record ▪ Employee

### CORPORATE OFFICE | *Non-Voting* | Annual Dues \$125

Adult Day Services corporate office representative, limited to one person designated to receive CAADS communications.

This membership category requires that ALL adult day services facilities owned/managed by the corporate office are in membership with CAADS.

### VENDOR | *Non-Voting* | Annual Dues \$550

Business offering products or services to adult day services providers.

Vendors who hold any of the following relationships with one or more adult day services facilities, must bring EACH such facility into membership before becoming eligible for Associate-Vendor membership:

- Stockholder or operating entity ▪ Administrator of Record ▪ Program Director of Record ▪ Employee

*Those providing start-up or operational consulting are ineligible for Associate-Vendor membership. See Consultant classification above.*
